



## 2021 Spring Tournament Series

TEES:	Boys 8 & Under: Purple (~1500 yards)	Girls 8 & Under: Purple
	Boys 9-10: Yellow Tees (~2300 yards)	Girls 9-10 Under: Yellow Tees
	Boys 11-12: Red Tees (~2900 yards)	Girls 11-12: Yellow Tees
	Boys 13 & up: White Tees (~3100 yards)	Girls 13 & Up: Red Tees

DISTANCE DEVICES: USGA Approved devices are permitted

FORMAT: 9-Hole Individual Stroke Play

SCORING: Players will earn points for each time they compete based on where they finish against the field. (1st place= 100 pts, 2nd = 80 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> place=70 pts etc.) Points will be accumulated during the season and the point totals will be awarded for the top 5 out of 6 finishes for each player (or the total if not all 6 events are played). Players will keep their own score as well as their competitor's, but no scorecards will be exchanged.

A score maximum of "double par" is in place for pace of play. Players must abide by the USGA rules of golf at all times. *"Whiffs" count as strokes.*

CADDIES AND SPECTATORS: Players have the option to use a caddy. The main role for a caddy in these events is to assist with pace of play. Caddies must refrain from excessive instruction during competitive play. If a caddy is causing undue delay of play they may be subject to penalty strokes or even disqualification. Caddies are encouraged to ensure players verify scores after every hole. Players are allowed 1 spectators in order to reduce the number of people on the course. Spectators are not permitted to provide advice for players and must remain on cart paths.

CELL PHONES: As a courtesy to others phones should be used for emergencies only and ringers should be on silent mode only.

PACE OF PLAY: All groups must keep within a ½ hole of the group in front of them. DO NOT LOSE SIGHT OF THE GROUP YOU ARE FOLLOWING. It should take 2.5 hours or LESS to complete 9 holes, an average of 15 minutes per hole.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Marked with white stakes. Proceed under rule 27 (stroke and distance). Play a provisional ball if you think you may have gone out of bounds.

PLAYOFFS: Ties will split points weekly. Ties for first place at the end of the season will be decided by sudden death play-off.

RULES: If in doubt of a rule play two balls (rule 3-3) and bring issue before rules committee.
