COVID-19 Protocols & Information

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE:

- Any players or spectators who are sick should stay home and not attend a tournament.
- To reduce the number of people on the golf course and common areas, 1 spectator is allowed per player. Spectators will be expected to adhere to social distancing guidelines. Failure to follow instructions may result in disqualification from the tournament.
- All participants and spectators will be expected to observe social distance guidelines during registration, warm ups, driving range, on the course and scoring at the end of the round.
- Players, caddies, spectators will be expected to adhere to safety guidelines in place at each golf course.
- We encourage players to bring push/pull carts. All players will be walking
- Due to high demand, golf carts may not be available in some cases. Be prepared to walk!

ONCE YOU ARRIVE & PLAYING THE ROUND:

- Upon arriving your junior should visit the check in table to notify us of their presence.
 Please look for First Tee signage near the first tee box. After checking in, your participant will be able to warm up and get ready for the round.
- Please make sure to check in on time. Tee times are limited and late arrivals will not be able to tee off at a later time
- Each player will receive a scorecard and keep their own score. No scorecards will be exchanged.
- At the end of the round, players will report to the scoring table with their group. Players
 will verbally confirm scores with their group and will then submit scorecards to chapter
 staff.

AFTER THE ROUND:

- Remember to maintain social distancing guidelines at all times
- As scorecards are submitted, scores will be displayed on score sheets. Award ceremonies will be held for the Top-3 players in each flight.
- Scores and standings will become available on the Spring Tournament Series page on our website the Monday following the tournament.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Caddies will be allowed for all players.
- Caddies must adhere to all safety policies and social distancing guidelines
- Younger players (ages 10 and under) are encouraged to have a caddy, particularly if oncourse experience is limited.

Caddy Do's

- Encourage your player & let them have fun
- Help keep up pace of play
- Help locate lost golf balls
- Help with club selection
- Help carry your player's equipment
- Help fix ball marks & care for the course

Caddy Don'ts

- Coach your player during tournaments.
- Put unnecessary pressure on players.
- Touch or remove flagsticks

- What to bring to tournaments?
 - o Golf balls
 - o Tees
 - o Ball Markers
 - o Sun protection (hat, sunscreen, umbrella, etc.)
 - o Water
 - o Comfortable shoes (soccer cleats, cleats with metal spikes not allowed)
 - Pushcart (if available)
